May in our Catholic tradition is dedicated in a special way to honoring our Blessed Mother, Mary. As we wish all of our "earthly mothers" Happy Mother's Day ... we reflect on Mary's special motherhood of Jesus and us. In the May issue of "The Central Minnesota Catholic," Bishop Patrick highlights Mary's role of standing at the foot of the cross of suffering humanity to bring them comfort. He suggests that each day of May we offer special prayers, perhaps the rosary or the Divine Mercy Chaplet for a particular group of people who are suffering: victims of the war in Ukraine or Gaza, the suffering people of Haiti, the millions of victims of human trafficking, migrant mothers fleeing violence and hunger, the imprisoned and their mothers and fathers. Offer your prayer for wisdom and courage to those facing a "difficult pregnancy" or for someone you know who needs assurance that they are wrapped in Mary's compassion and love.
